

## Potentials of the Hydrogen-pH-Electrode pHydrunio in buffer pH 0 versus calomel electrode at 25°C

In the calibration solution Buffer pH 0, different values for the outer and inner electrodes of the pHydrunio result against the calomel electrode.

The hydrogen potentials in buffer pH 0 for the outer or in pH 7 for the inner hydrogen electrode are calculated using the Nernst equation.

The values of the calomel electrode to be considered are taken from
